

BIOGRAPHY OF CW5 ARTHUR G. DAHL IV
Chief Warrant Officer of the Branch – Ordnance



CW5 Arthur G. Dahl IV was born in Albuquerque, New Mexico. He completed basic training and advanced individual training in 1984 and entered the Army as a Track Vehicle repairer. His initial assignment was with 3rd Corps Support Command, 588th Maintenance Company located in Giessen, Germany. While there he served as a track vehicle repairer, and later became an assistant squad leader. In 1986, CW5 Dahl was assigned to the 24th Infantry Division, 2nd Forward Support Battalion supporting 4/64 Armor where he later achieved the rank of Sergeant. Following selection and completion to Warrant Officer Candidate school, CW5 Dahl graduated and was assigned to the 9th Infantry Division, 3/11 Field Artillery at Fort Lewis, Washington. In 1990 he served as the Battalion Maintenance Technician/Officer until reassignment in 1993 to Fort Polk, Louisiana. There he served as the Support Maintenance Technician/Officer with the 2nd Armored Cavalry Regiment (ACR), Regimental Support Squadron until 1994. From 1994 until 1997 CW5 Dahl was assigned to the 1st Armored Division, 1st Brigade Combat Team, 23rd Combat Engineers. While serving with the 23rd, in 1995 he was deployed for a year to Bosnia-Herzegovina, Camp Kime supporting the initial IFOR rotation. In 1997 he was assigned to 43rd Area Support Group, as the ASG Group Officer at Fort Carson, Colorado. After completing the Warrant Officer Advanced Course, he was assigned to 1/68 Armor as the Battalion Maintenance Technician/Officer. In 2000 CW5 Dahl was assigned to the 11th Signal Brigade as the Brigade Maintenance Technician/Officer. While stationed at Fort Huachuca, Arizona CW5 Dahl completed the Warrant Officer Staff Course and later deployed to Operation Iraqi Freedom (OIF) until the duration of the War. In July 2003, CW5 Dahl was nominated and assumed his duties as the Senior Maintenance Officer/Advisor to the Commanding General and Director of G-3 of Tank-automotive and Armaments Command (TACOM) headquartered in Warren, Michigan.

CW5 Dahl earned an Associate in Technology from Pierce College, a Bachelor of Science degree from Southern Illinois University, and a Masters of Business Administration (MBA) from the University of Phoenix. His military schooling includes Basic Training, AIT, Primary leader's development course (PLDC), and BNCO. He is also a graduate of the Ordnance Warrant Officer Basic Course (WOBC), Warrant Officer Advanced Course (WOAC), and the Warrant Officer Staff Course (WOSC), Level I Life Cycle Logistics (Certified). He has also been inducted into the coveted Ordnance "Order of Samuel Sharpe".

CW5 Dahl's awards and decorations include The Legion of Merit, The Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (3OLC), Army Commendation (4OLC), Army achievement (4OLC), Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary and Service, NATO Medal, Humanitarian Service Medal, Yugoslavia Campaign medal, National Defense Service medal, Overseas ribbon (2OLC), NCOPD ribbon (2OLC), Army Service ribbon, Mechanic and Driver Badge, Combat Action Badge. He has also been inducted into the coveted Ordnance "Order of Samuel Sharpe".

Married to the former Diane Robinson of Burke, Virginia and has a daughter Ashleigh age 17, and a son Ryan age 13.
