ANNEX A (Narrative) to OPORD 04-54

WARRANT OFFICER CHANGE OF INSIGNIA SEQUENCE:

1. * UNIT IS FORMED AS APPROPRIATE WITH ALL CHIEF WARRANT OFFICERS IN A SEPARATE FORMATION.
2. 36TH ENGINEER GROUP COMMANDER IS IN POSITION AND HONORS TO THE NATION ARE RENDERED.

3. THE SENIOR CHIEF WARRANT OFFICERS WILL READ THE FOLLOWING:

"TODAY WE RECOGNIZE A HISTORIC MILESTONE IN THE PROFESSIONAL EVOLUTION OF THE U.S. ARMY WARRANT OFFICER CORPS. TODAY THESE WARRANT OFFICERS EXCHANGE THE VENERABLE "EAGLE RISING" COLLAR INSIGNIA FOR THE EQUALLY VENERABLE INSIGNIA OF THEIR INDIVIDUAL SERVICE BRANCHES. OVER THE MANY YEARS, BRANCHES HAVE BENEFITED IMMEASURABLY FROM THE PROFESSIONAL TECHNICAL EXPERTISE AND OPERATIONAL MILITARY ACUMEN OF THEIR WARRANT OFFICERS. THE TRADITIONAL WARRANT OFFICER COLLAR INSIGNIA, AN EAGLE RISING WITH WINGS DISPLAYED, STANDING ON A BUNDLE OF TWO ARROWS, ALL ENCLOSED IN A WREATH OF GOLD, IS A COMBINATION OF MILITARY SYMBOLS SIGNIFYING STRENGTH, ACHIEVEMENT AND PROWESS IN COMBAT. THE "EAGLE RISING" INSIGNIA, ORIGINALLY ADOPTED IN 1921, IS EMBLEMATIC OF A TIME WHEN WARRANT OFFICERS' TECHNICAL SKILLS AND DUTIES COULD BE TRANSFERRED BETWEEN SERVICE ARMS EASILY AND WITH LITTLE FORMAL TRAINING. THE CONTEMPORARY WARRANT OFFICER HAS VERY FOCUSED, COMPLEX AND SPECIFIC TECHNICAL SKILLS AND ABILITIES HONED THROUGH EXTENSIVE TECHNICAL TRAINING AND APPLIED TO THE MISSION OF A SINGLE BRANCH OR FUNCTIONAL AREA. IN RECOGNITION OF THE BRANCH FOCUSED ROLES AS SEASONED, SPECIALIZED TECHNICIANS, EFFECTIVE TODAY, 9 JULY 2004, BY ORDER OF THE CHIEF OF STAFF, ARMY, WARRANT OFFICERS WILL WEAR THE INSIGNIA OF THEIR INDIVIDUAL BRANCH OF THEIR SPECIFIC BRANCH TECHNICAL QUALIFICATIONS.

4. THE GROUP COMMANDER REMOVES THE OLD COLLAR INSIGNIA FOR EACH WARRANT OFFICER PRESENT AND IN TURN REPLACES IT WITH THE DESIGNATED BRANCH INSIGNIA.

5. UPON COMPLETION OF THE RANK INSIGNIA EXCHANGE, THE COMMANDER MAKES HIS COMMENTS.
